## SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL NMQHA APPROVED SHOWS

**RULES-** The shows will be governed by AQHA rules and all AQHA rules will prevail.

**MEMBERSHIP-** Every exhibitor, rider and owner competing in AQHA classes must possess a current AQHA, AQHYA or AQHA amateur membership card in accordance with AQHA rule #102, or must complete a membership applications and pay for it at the show. Replacement cards are available at the show before entering.

### NMQHA MEMBERSHIP – PLEASE READ

In order to be eligible for any year end awards you must hold a current membership with NMQHA. This can be a family membership, an individual membership or a youth (non-voting) membership; however the exhibitor and owner(s) must both be members of NMQHA.

**SHAVINGS-** The feed store should be open during move in for a show. If late arrival is necessary (after 5:00 PM) and you have stalls reserved call Expo NM 505-265-7891 and ask for feed store.

**DAMAGE–** All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Expo NM properties and will be billed accordingly.

**SECURITY-** For security reasons, please keep vehicles, trailers and tack rooms locked at all times. NMQHA, NMQHVA or Expo NM will not assume any responsibility for any theft or vandalism.

**DRUG TESTING –**All AQHA horses will be subject to drug testing according to AQHA drug testing program.

**PROTEST -**Any protest must be made in writing to the show management within 24 hours accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 cash or certified check, which sum will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. All protests will be brought before NMQHA Board of Directors for final decisions at the next scheduled meeting.

**BAD CHECKS-** There will be a \$25.00 penalty plus any bank charges added for any returned checks. NMQHA AND AQHA rules shall apply.

**AWARDS-** Circuit awards to the Highpoint and Reserve High Point in each AQHA Division (except Green Horse) and 11 & under All Breed. Green Horse classes do not count for circuit awards or AQHA Incentive Funds. **You must show to all judges to qualify for circuit awards.**

**TIES-** Ties will be broken by the following using the AQHA point system

1. The most number of first places
2. The most horses beaten
3. The most number of second places
4. The toss of a coin

Combined Sr. and Jr. Horse classes will go in the Sr. Horse slot and **combining MUST** be done before the Jr. Horse class begins and then ONLY with permission from all exhibitors and show management. For combined classes with patterns, the Sr. Horse pattern will be used.

As per AQHA rule 408 (b); Management **will combine** Amateur and Amateur Select classes back into an all-age when there are less than 3 entries in the amateur or select classes. For combined classes with patterns, the Amateur pattern will be used. Points for NMQHA will go to the division entered.

Combined Novice Youth classes will go in the 14-18 slot, points for AQHA and NMQHA will go to appropriate age group for year-end points. For classes with patterns, the 14-18 patterns will be used.
